Notice of Advice for Patients Requesting Physical Therapy Treatment under New York's Direct Access Law

Thank you for choosing United Rehab Physical Therapy as your physical therapy provider.

You have decided to utilize our services under New York's "Direct Access to Physical Therapy" law, which is effective November 23, 2006. Under this law, you may be treated by a physical therapist without a prescription or referral. You may be evaluated and/or treated by a licensed physical therapist for up to 10 visits or 30 days, whichever comes first.

We are required to inform you that this treatment <u>may not</u> be paid by your insurance carrier if you have not obtained a prescription for physical therapy from a physician, dentist, podiatrist, or nurse practitioner licensed to practice in New York State. We are also required to inform you that this treatment may be paid by your insurance carrier if you were to have obtained a valid prescription.

I have read this form and acknowledge that I am about to obtain physical therapy treatment for myself, or my minor child, under New York's Direct Access Law. I understand that my insurance carrier may not pay for these services since I have not obtained a prescription from a New York State licensed physician, dentist, podiatrist, or nurse practitioner. I understand and accept that this will make me personally liable for today's charges as well as future treatment under the Direct Access Law.
